Character and Spiritual Leader Scholarship

The St. Joseph PTA Council has established a \$1,000 scholarship for incoming High School Seniors. Each Spring, Juniors are invited to submit applications. The chosen applicant will be announced on our website, stjoeppta.org and we will email them. The scholarship recipient will then attend PTA Council meetings and other events throughout their Senior year. More information about that is provided below. The student will receive their scholarship award at the May PTA Council meeting they attend (the last meeting of the school year).

REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a graduating senior of a St. Joseph Public School (will be a Junior when applying).
- Must be a member of their high school PTSA for the current year.
- Must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA.
- Must have one (1) letter of recommendation from school personnel.
(Ex: Teacher, Principal or Guidance Counselor.)
- Must complete the application attached.
- Must attach a transcript with application.
- Must write and attach an essay on your goals for college and career (150 words or less).

THE AWARD RECIPIENT:

- Must attend 5 general meetings of the St. Joseph PTA Council and the Founder's Day Dinner and be prepared with a motivational "thought for the evening" at these meetings. Meetings are every second Thursday of the month. Founders Day is the second Thursday in February.
- Must prepare monthly motivational thoughts, short poem or quote to be published in our monthly newsletter (Council Clippings). This does not have to be an original work of art.

**Though not mandatory, please enclose a photo. It is good to have a face with a name.

Application Process

Applications will be available at the guidance counselor office for current Juniors. Applications are due to the guidance counselor no later than Thursday, May 9th of the current year. Selection will be made by June of the current year. Applications will be forwarded to PTA Council Awards chairman by the school's counselor.
