MOPTA Scholarship opportunities



Unit in Good Standing...

To be a unit in good standing with the State PTA you must...

- Submit your financial review by Dec. 1
- Submit your annual report by Dec. 1
- Submit your IRS tax confirmation by Dec. 1
- Submit membership monthly
- Bylaws must be current (no need to submit a copy if current)
- New Officers list must be submitted by March 31st each year

Reports are now past due! If you have not submitted them to State PTA and Council, please do so as soon as possible!



Just a friendly reminder that March is election month for new officers for 2026-2027! Results from you March election deadline is March 31st. Submit to MOPTA and St. Joseph PTA Council to be in good standing.
